The Wine

Rosé (especially one made from the Spanish-clone of Grenache) checks all the Ragbag WineWorks boxes: it's delicious, full of flavor, has great acidity and goes with all kinds of food. It's the perfect grape for sunny days (originally hailing from the warm interior of Spain) just as it glows when the sun goes down! We love our wines too much to subject them to oak barrels so our wine was fermented and aged in stainless-steel to preserve all the flavor and liveliness that characterizes it.

The Vineyard

The 2018 Ragbag WineWorks Garnacha Rosé was crafted from fruit grown on the spectacular, head-trained Sheldon Hills Vineyard in Elk Grove at the northern tip of the Lodi appellation. Harvested at low-sugar to maintain acidity and keep alcohol levels down, we did the absolute least we could do in the winery, preferring—instead—to make an honest, self-possessed wine having only what it needs...and nothing it doesn't!

ABV: 12.2%

Aging: 100% Stainless-steel
