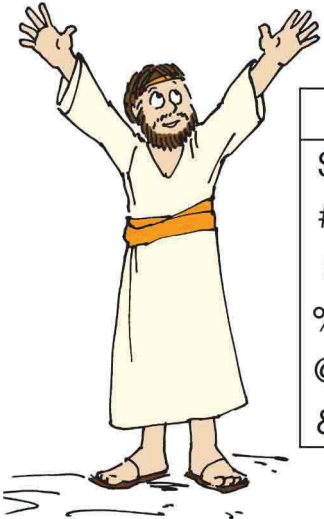




Paul prayed with confidence for the Philippians because he trusted God's purpose for them.
