By your grace, we are called into the sacred labors of justice and transformation. We become free in Christ to reject all evil and oppression. Like those who gathered with Jesus on the night of his arrest, we come in need of grace...

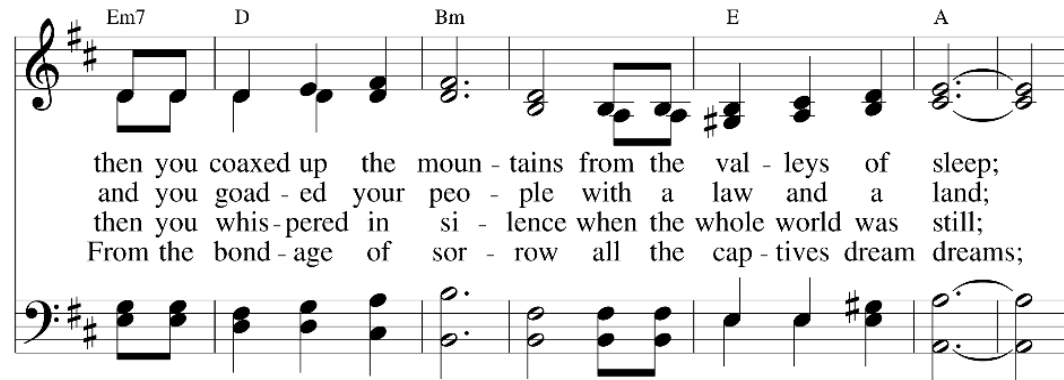

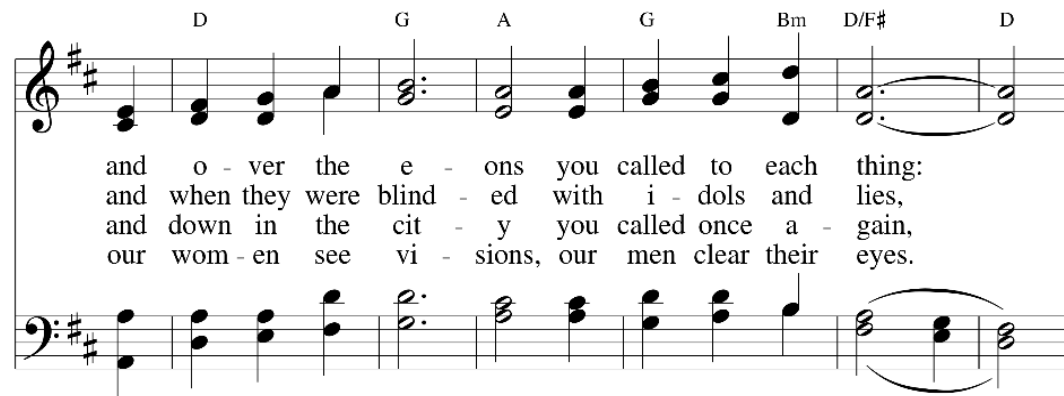

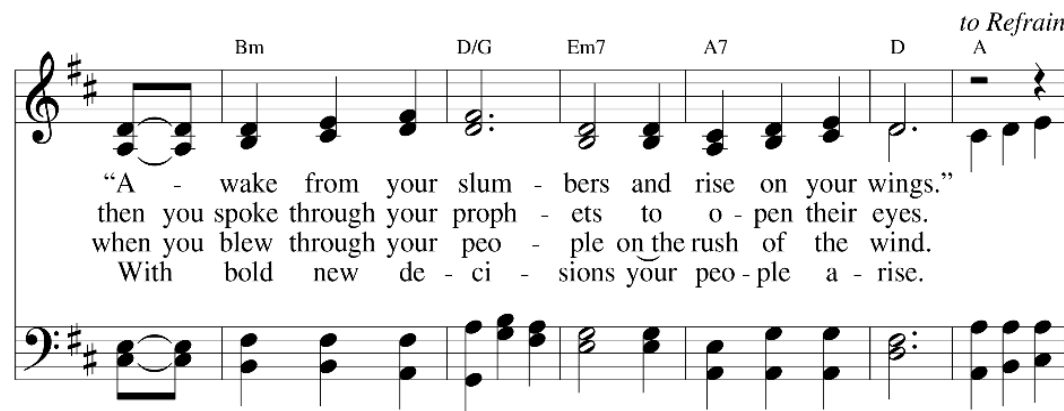
