

Ansel Adams (1902-1984) is perhaps the most widely known and beloved photographer in the history of the United States; the popularity of his work has only increased since his death. Adams's most important work was devoted to what was or appeared to be the country's remaining fragments of untouched wilderness, especially in national parks and other protected areas of the American West. He was also a

vigorous and outspoken leader of the conservation movement.

APR 13 Hans Miles, Ceramic Artist

Notre Dame Grad student in ceramics

With BFA from Arizona State University, Hans joined the Graduate Program in Ceramics at Notre Dame in 2021. His investigations have led him to continue large-scale ceramic sculpture.

APR 20 Coleton Lunt, Ceramic Artist

Lunt finished his MFA in Ceramics at Notre Dame in 2020. After a time at the Belger Crane Studios as an artist-in-residence, he returned to Notre Dame as a Teaching Scholar. His current work draws parallels between biological evolution and the evolution of his personal craft.

APR 27 Bill Kremer, Michiana Master & Professor of Ceramics, Notre Dame

A renowned artist known for his large-scale sculptural vessels, Kremer is the most award winning artist in the history of the Elkhart Juried Regional. After a 50-year career teaching, he will retire in May.

MAY 4 Randy Roberts, Assistant Curator

Roberts highlights works in the MMAA Permanent Collection and delves deeper into the lives of the artists represented.

MAY 11 America the Beautiful

Director/Curator, Brian Byrn introduces this landmark exhibit through the film by the same name that is narrated by Clyde & Niki Butcher. (running time 50 min; allow for extra time)

MAY 18 Jonathan Canning, Director Brauer Art Museum, Valparaiso University

Canning lived the majority of his childhood in Britain, where he then went on to receive his undergraduate degree in Art History at the Courtauld Institute of Art. Canning then obtained his master's degree at the University of Delaware and a Master's in Philosophy at Columbia University. He eventually moved to Chicago, where he was hired at Loyola University Chicago. Canning was appointed Director at the Brauer at the beginning of the 2022-23 school year.

MAY 25 Janet Bloch, Director Lubeznik Center for the Arts

Bloch joined the LCA as Education Director in 2009. She held this position for over seven years. In 2016, Block was appointed to Executive Director. Bloch was connected to the art world even before she joined Lubeznik. She states, "I am from Chicago, and I have worked in the non-profit world for a long time. I used to run a women's gallery in Chicago that was a non-profit before I moved to Michigan City."
