Director/Curator, Brian Byrn, opened the evening followed with comments from Jennifer Burns Abrell, Chair of the MMAA Trustees. Dr. Rick Burns and Dr. Daniel Burns MMAA Trustees, gave out Purchase Awards for the evening; 33 artists received awards totalling \$27,000. There were 217 artists who entered 380 works overall from which the judge selected 164 works by 147 artists.

#### Mark Ruschman's Judge's Statement:

"My approach for selecting what gets into a show is informed by my four decades in the art world. After an initial walk-through of the entries, I evaluated each piece on quality of execution, level of creativity, attention to formal elements like composition, perspective, and ultimately, whether the artist was successful in what they were trying to accomplish. The fact that 164 pieces made it into the show tells you everything about the quality of the work."

Mary Burke, Berrien Springs, MI, was a former Best of Show winner. This year she received the Dr.s Dan & Linda Burns Purchase Award for her painting, Multipicity, and the Dr. Rick & Cindy Burns Purchase Award for a second work titled, Scratch Pad.



Dick Lehman, Goshen, IN, received the Jim & Bev Haas Purchase Award for his ceramic Wall Platter.
