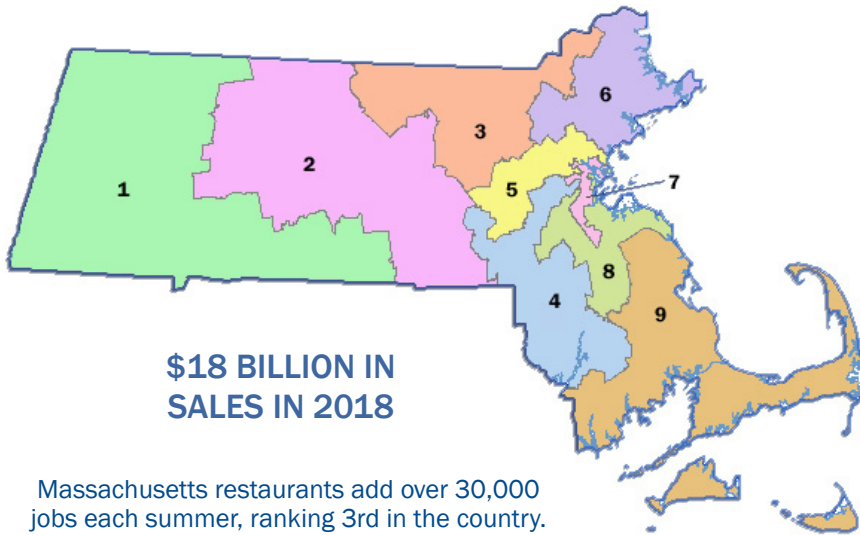

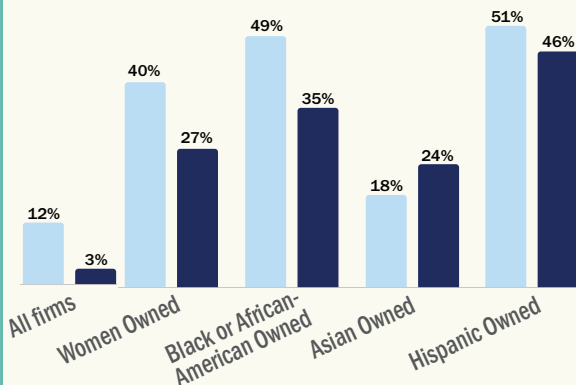

Eating & Drinking Places versus All U.S. Businesses:

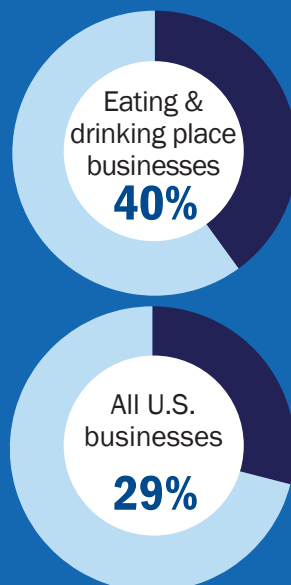

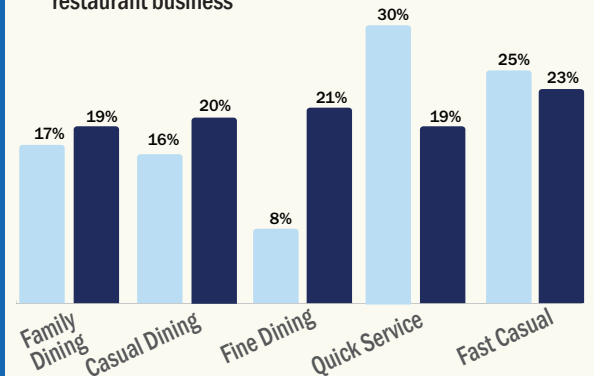
PROPORTION OF BUSINESSES THAT ARE MAJORITY-OWNED BY MINORITIES
