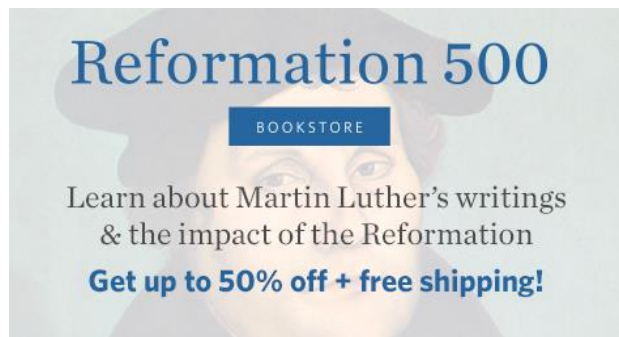

Visiting Professor Dr. Eric Crump will join us to commemorate Luther's Birthday and the Reformation with a lecture "Law and Gospel: A Proposal for a Reformation."

Dr. Eric Crump was born in Charlottesville, Virginia and received his BA from St. Olaf College in 1975 majoring in philosophical theology, hermeneutics and literary theory, and theoretical physics. He received his M.A. in Divinity in 1977 and his Ph.D. in Systematic Theology in 1989 from The Divinity School of the University of Chicago with a dissertation entitled: *"Imagination, Representation, and Faith: Foundations for a Revised Representational Christology."* Dr. Crump taught at the Theological Seminary at Gettysburg from 1991-2009 in systematics, historical theology, and theological ethics.



Dr. Eric Crump will present a lecture at St Michael Lutheran Church on Thursday, November 9, 2017 at 7:00 PM. An open forum will follow his lecture addressing *A Proposal for the Reformation of Law and Gospel*. Dr. Crump will explore the intricacies surrounding natural law, the Decalogue, and Jesus' great love commandment.

Dr. Crump will also join us on Sunday, November 12, 2017 between worship services (8:30 AM and 11:00 PM) for Adult Sunday school to continue the conversation surrounding how Lutheran's interpret God's Law and the Good News received through God's Word.

All are welcome to attend these two opportunities to visit with our Professor in Residence as we continue our commemoration of Luther's 95 Theses.
