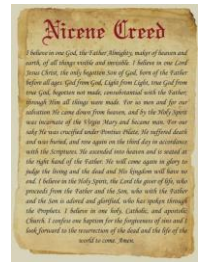

*Gordon W. Lathrop is Professor of Liturgy Emeritus at the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Philadelphia. In 2006-2011, he was also Visiting Professor of Liturgical Studies at Yale Divinity School and the Institute of Sacred Music in New Haven, CT. A pastor of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, he is the author several books. He was a participant on two drafting committees involved in the preparation of the North American liturgical resource, *Evangelical Lutheran Worship* (2006). He has lectured widely, in several countries, and participated in the work of the Faith and Order Commission of the World Council of Churches and the Worship and Culture Study of the Lutheran World Federation. He is Past-President of both the North American Academy of Liturgy and the International Societas Liturgica. He lives in Arlington, VA.*
