Zacchaeus was a real Christian, he

B. Thoughts

1. He was curious about Jesus (v. 3).
2. He was willing to go out of his way to see Jesus (v. 4).
3. He was willing to suffer some abuse and loss of pride to see Jesus (v. 4).
4. He needed Jesus because he was a sinner (v. 7).
5. He was singled out (chosen) by Jesus (v. 5).
6. He was ready and glad to welcome Jesus (v. 6).
7. He boldly ("stood up") repented of sin. Offered restitution beyond the demands of the law (v. 8).
8. A longing for wholeness and completeness.
 - a. A son of Abraham (v. 9).
 - b. He knew from whom and where he had come, but didn't know how to complete the journey! Jesus intervenes and leads the way home!!
