Jacob & Hosanna have been serving in church planting ministry for the last twenty years in a Muslim country in South Asia. The Muslim people group among whom they work number over 190 million, among whom there are only a few thousand believers. They are involved particularly with church planting, youth ministry and developing media outreach resources. Being a restricted access country, Jacob works as a graphic designer for a local company, which provides them a partial salary and a visa.

They have three children: Elias 18, Maia 16, and Obed 9. Hosanna and Jacob met in boarding school in India in the mid-90s as both Jacob's and Hosanna's parents were involved in church planting in Asia. Thus, many things in Asia are 'home' to them—the spice, hospitality, heat, and mosquitoes. But the unique challenges of pollution, terrorism, and treatment of women are difficult.

- Pray that God would send more workers to those who haven't had an opportunity to hear about the new life in Jesus.
- Pray that we would be drawn into increasing intimacy with God.
