Throw Away the Keys

Galatians 3:23-29

A. Context.

- Written by the apostle Paul, probably from Antioch in Syria, after the first missionary journey and probably before the Council at Jerusalem (Acts 15).
- It was likely written to the churches started by Paul and Barnabas in southern Galatia (Lystra, Derbe, Iconium, Pisisdian Antioch) during the first journey.
- All of these churches had responded to the gospel preached by Paul and recognized him as an apostle of Jesus Christ.
- In a brief period of time, the Jewish believers have taken control of the Gentile believers and attempted to persuade them that they must be subject to the Law and all its requirements.
 - They are defying Paul's proclamation of justification by faith through grace and adding to it all the old requirements of Jewish law and worship.
 - Coupled with this is a denunciation of Paul, claiming he is a false apostle, a charge he rejects and proves false in the opening chapters.
- In verses 23-29, Paul concludes his defense with a reiteration of the results of the gospel of grace.
 - Previously, he says, we were "locked up" and "held in custody" by the law.
 Once Christ came and justified us through His crucifixion and resurrection, we
 no longer need a guardian (vv. 23-24).
 - Christ now lives in us through His Spirit and we don't have to prove ourselves by the Law.
 - Everyone who is "in Christ Jesus" (v. 26) is "clothed with Christ" (v. 27). We are new people.
 - We do not fit into the old categories such as "Jew or Gentile, slave or free, male or female" (v. 28).
 - In regard to our freedom and fullness in the church, we all belong to Christ and we are all heirs to the fruit and blessings of the promise of the kingdom of God.
- C. The Galatians reverted back to the custody of the Law.
 - What kind of 'former lives" hold us in custody and keep us locked up?
 - 2. It's time to "throw the keys away!"
