JOB LEARNS TO TRUST GOD'S WISDOM
JOB 38:1-18; 42:1-6

THEME
Sometimes God doesn't explain our suffering; He reveals Himself.

APPLICATION
When God speaks in our storms, He gives peace before He changes our circumstances.

MAIN POINTS

- 1 Heaven speaks after seasons of silence.
God had not abandoned Job.
- 2 Heaven reminds us who is truly in control.
"Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation?"
- 3 Heaven restores those who continue to trust.
Job's greatest blessing wasn't restored wealth—it was a deeper knowledge of God.
