COMMISSION ON ACCREDITATION OF REHABILITATION FACILITIES (CARF) 101 TRAINING

Presented by CARF staff, CARF 101 is intended for a variety of organizations, including those that are exploring CARF accreditation, preparing for their first CARF survey, or who need a refresher prior to a CARF resurvey. Topics vary depending on the audience and may include:

- An overview of the accreditation process
- An overview of CARF standards
- Examples of conformance to CARF standards

Training consists of a comprehensive and engaging two-day session designed to help organizations prepare for successful accreditation. Participants will be given the opportunity to discuss and receive hands-on support from trainers regarding the development and implementation of CARF standards. Additional emphasis will be placed on areas where those new to CARF often need the most guidance. Participants will have the opportunity to consult with the faculty one-on-one and participate with other attendees in break-out sessions.
