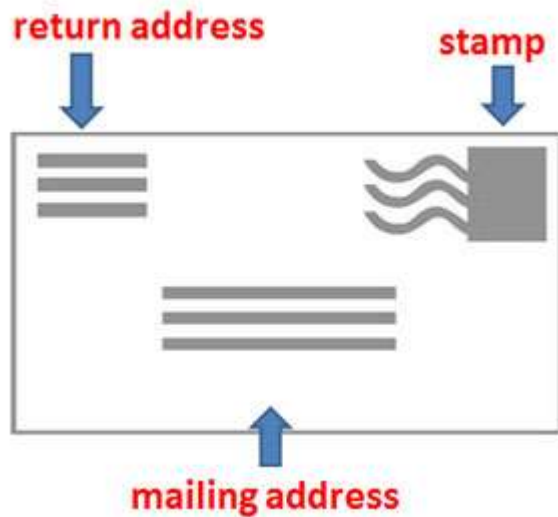


Envelopes and Addresses

We use envelopes to send letters. We write the mailing address and the return address on the front of the envelope. After we write the addresses, we put a stamp in the upper right corner of the envelope.



Envelope

- The **mailing address** is near the center of the envelope.
- The **return address** is in the upper left corner.
- The stamp is in the upper right corner.
