This is an inefficient paradigm, plus the expense to expose the teams to this level of creative problem solving is difficult and costly. Our national events are great, but they are once a year. Each week that passes is a profit opportunity lost! By coming to the Builder's backyard, OpEX lets builders have more team members be exposed to game changing ideas quickly and earlier in the cycle."

For many folks, it is hard to admit difficulties, and privacy is always a concern, but OpEX has addressed that with lots of free time to connect and the attendees can freely circulate to the tables by topic.
