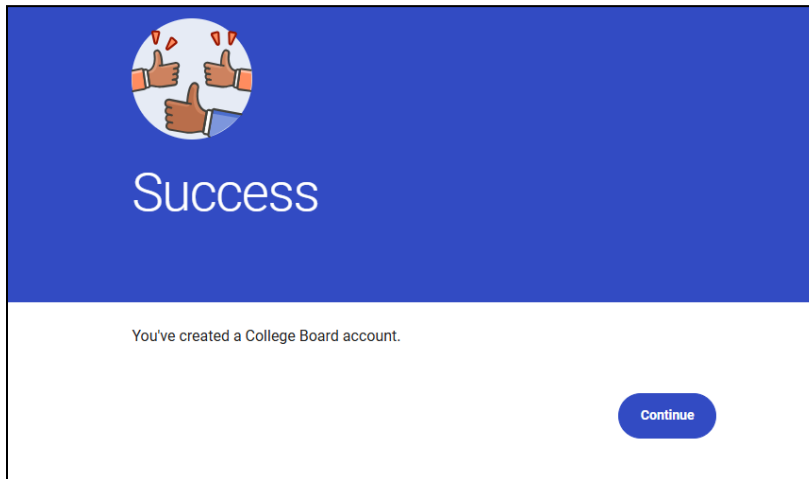


## How to Register for the SAT

1. Create a College Board Account
  - a. Visit <https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/sat/registration> and click “Register Now.”
  - b. You’ll use the same account to access your SAT Scores and register for future tests.
  - c. You will need to enter both student and parent information.
    - i. Please note: the student's email and your parents' email CANNOT be the same.

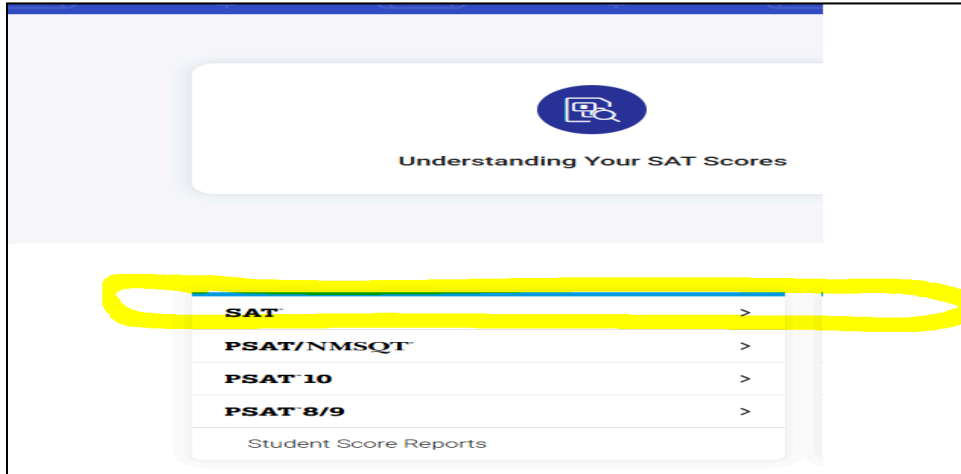


2. A verification code will be sent to both your email and phone to verify both your email and phone.
3. Once both codes have been entered, your account will be successfully created.



4. Click continue

5. Click on SAT



6. You will be provided with a list of dates and deadlines for upcoming tests.
7. Click on "See all Dates"
8. Register for the date you want to take the test.

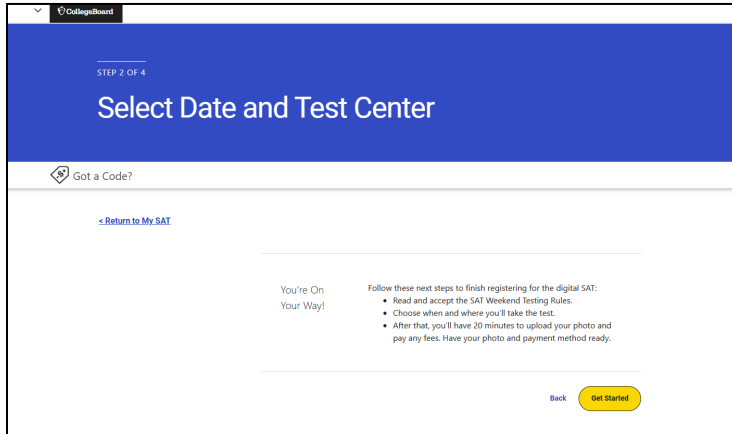

9. You can enter a Fee Waiver code from your school counselor if you qualify.
  - a. Please note: this is NOT provided by IMSA.
10. You will verify your information again.
11. Enter your student profile information.

- a. This will be a several-page log and will ask about courses taken and when. Please have that information ready.

12. Select a date and test Center and click continue

- a. After selecting your date and location, you'll have 20 minutes to complete the rest of your registration.



13. You will be prompted to upload of photo of the student.

14. Once the photo is uploaded, complete registration and pay for your test.

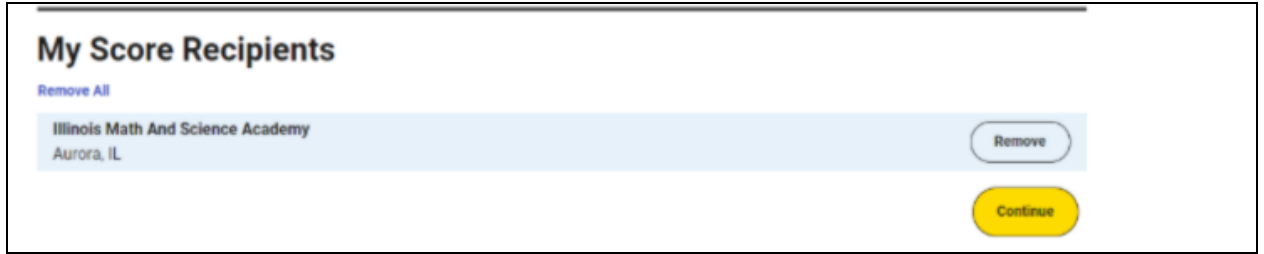
15. Confirm testing information and input payment.

## Is there a fee for sending scores?

Each time you register to take the SAT on a weekend, you can send your score to up to four organizations for free. You can designate your score recipients at the time you register or any time until you take the test. You also have until nine days after the test to use or change your free score sends. After that, there's a fee.

If you take the SAT during the week at your school, you must choose your free score sends during exam setup or within three days after testing, as instructed by your school. To make or change your selections within those three days, use your sign-in ticket from this test to sign in to Bluebook™. Then go to **Your Tests > Past** where this test will be listed and click **SAT Score Sends**.

16. Immediately upon registering for the exam, you will receive a pop-up for where you would like your scores to be sent. **IMSA's code is 3027**



17. Once you register for the exam, please send a picture of your admission ticket to [admissions@imsa.edu](mailto:admissions@imsa.edu).
18. If you have already registered and missed the "Pop-up," you can have your scores sent by going through your [CollegBoard.org](https://collegboard.org) profile.
  - a. Select the specific test you want to send the scores for.
19. Select the "I want to" option and click "Send score report," and enter IMSA's school code **3027**.
