The High Holiday Packet has been sent out via email and is also available on the homepage of our website at [www.bjcst.org](http://www.bjcst.org). The entire registration will take place exclusively online once again this year. If you need any assistance completing your form, please feel free to contact Matthew or Ilana in the Shul office, and they will be able to assist you.

Please be advised of the following important information regarding the High Holiday registration form:

- We will be having two Minyanim on Rosh Hashanah Day, and Yom Kippur Day, they will be at 8:00 am in the "Gym" and 9:30 am in the Old Sanctuary. The location you select for Yom Kippur will be the location that you will be in for all of the Yom Kippur services.
- As you fill out your reservations, we ask that you only reserve a seat if you will be using it. If you will not be joining us this year, please use the check box in the seating section to let us know that you will not require a seat.
- We are planning this year to have childcare once again for the High Holidays. **At this time, we are not taking reservations but rather completing a needs assessment to see what the demand will be for High Holiday childcare. Please note, that by completing this form, you are not officially registered for childcare. Additionally, once childcare is made available it will be \$25 per child per session, and it will only be available for children between the ages of 2-11.**
- It is the policy of the shul to have all accounts current as to Membership dues and outstanding pledges, before High Holiday seats are processed. Please contact Matthew Hocherman directly at [matthew@bjcst.org](mailto:matthew@bjcst.org), if you need any financial assistance.
- **This High Holiday Form includes many items other than High Holiday seats. So even if you will not be here for Rosh Hashanah & Yom Kippur, we strongly encourage you to review the High Holiday form, and fill it out completely.**
- Please make every effort to submit your form to the Shul office by Friday, August 20th. The sooner we receive your information, the more efficiently and effectively we can plan.
