SECURITY ENHANCEMENT UPDATE

Dear Friends,

As mentioned in our previous communiques, we are constantly looking for ways to improve our security measures.

Beginning this week, Shabbos Morning, there will be a new process to allow entry into the building.

There will be a pop-up tent located on the ramp leading to the sidewalk outside of the Shul. We will also have the parking spots on the right and left of this ramp roped off. Thus, the only way to access the building will be to go through the pop-up tent checkpoint.

When entering through the checkpoint, our hired security officer will be there to ensure that all those who are entering are permitted on campus.

Additionally, our security officers will use a metal detecting wand to check any suspicious bags prior to allowing people to enter. If you are carrying a firearm, please share this information in advance with our security officers.

Our BJC Security Team will be stationed inside the building and will be called out if needed to verify if someone is able to enter the building or not.

As we implement this new process, we need your help to ensure these protocols are followed. We thank you for your partnership to help ensure the safety of our community.

Boca Jewish Center Tisha B'Av Guidelines

Laws of Shabbos Erev Tisha B'av (August 5-6)

When Tisha B'Av falls out on a Sunday, as it does this year, we undergo an abrupt transition from celebrating Shabbos to mourning the loss of Beis HaMikdash. An overview of the procedure for this transition is as follows:

Mincha and Shalosh Seudos:

- Mincha will be at 6:00 PM to allow time for everyone to go home and partake in the final meal before Tisha B'Av, the Seudah Hamafsekes.
- At Shalosh Seudos, none of the standard restrictions of the Seudah Hamafsekes apply. As such, the usual custom of eating eggs with ashes is not observed.
- The Seudah must be completed by sunset (8:04 PM), as that is when the restriction of eating and drinking commences.

Havdalah on Motzei Shabbos:

- The full Havdalah is not recited on Motzei Shabbos. Rather, the Bracha on fire alone is recited after Maariv.
- Before performing any forbidden Melachah one must recite "Baruch Hamavdil Bein Kodesh Lechol".
- Anyone who needs to eat on Tisha B'Av night or day, must first recite Havdalah.

Shoes:

- One may not put on their non-leather shoes until the conclusion of Shabbos (8:41 PM), after the recitation of "Baruch Hamavdil..."
- Maariv & Eichah is scheduled at 9:05 PM to allow time for people to put on their non-leather shoes at home and drive to Shul.

Laws of Tisha B'Av (August 6 & 7)

The primary restrictions of Tisha B'Av pertain to the areas outlined below:

- Any eating and drinking are forbidden, including rinsing the mouth and brushing teeth.
- If you have health concerns about fasting, please contact Rabbi Gibber.
- Washing - All washing for pleasure is prohibited, even in cold water.
- One may wash his/her fingers up to the knuckles (e.g. for Netilas Yadayim).
- Anointing - Perfume should not be worn.
- Leather Shoes – Shoes made of any amount of leather should not be worn.

Additional Restrictions:


- It is prohibited to study Torah topics other than those relevant to Tisha B'Av or mourning.
- Sitting on a regular chair/bench is forbidden until midday (1:27 PM). One may, however, sit on a low bench or chair, or on a cushion on the floor.

Conclusion of the Fast:

- At the conclusion of the fast (8:40 PM), one may not eat or drink until Havdalah has been recited.
- For Havdalah after the fast, one should recite only the Berachas of "Borei Pri Hagafen" and "Hamavdil Bein Kodesh L'chol..." (omitting the Beracha for spices and fire, as well as the introductory verses of "Hinei...").

Laws for the Day after Tisha B'Av

If the ninth of Av falls on Shabbat, in which case the fast is delayed until the tenth, many of the restrictions applicable to the Nine Days end when the fast ends, and havdalah wine, music, bathing and haircutting are permitted. However, we do not eat meat or drink other wine until the next morning.
