



IMPORTANT YOUTH REMINDERS

As you all know, Covid-19 has been spreading. As before, the situation is a moving and complex target and there are many opinions on how to handle the current environment. With that being said, we are strongly encouraging all children to NOT come to shul if they are not feeling well for any reason at all.

As a reminder, the breakdown of our Youth Rooms are as follows:

Boys & Girls in EC3 & EC4 will be in the room with the mirrors.

Boys & Girls in K – 2nd grade will be in the library.

Girls in 3rd – 6th grade will be at the end of the hallway.

Boys in 3rd – 6th grade will be in the large multipurpose room.

Please note that parents are expected to pick up their children from groups at the conclusion of Davening, prior to taking part in the Kiddush as the counselors will be leaving at that time, and there will be no supervision. All children should be picked up from the original location that they were dropped off in.

Children who are outdoors MUST be at least 7 years old AND part of groups, even if they weren't part of groups prior to the outdoor time. They must also follow the instructions of the group leaders. Otherwise, they have to be inside.

Please remember that in order for our Shabbos morning groups to be successful, we need your help!

- Parents are kindly asked NOT to remain in groups with their children.
- Kids are not allowed to leave during groups, except to go to the restroom.
- Kids should either be in groups or with their parents, not wandering around on their own.
- The hallway by the small shul is a "Noise Free Zone" please do not congregate in that area.



Gila's Way: Mental Health & Suicide Awareness

Lessons to learn regarding the Value of Life



On December 5, 2019 Rabbi Shalom Hammer's 18 year old daughter died by suicide. This presentation reveals Gila's story and what lead to the tragic end of her life. The presentation addresses Mental Health awareness and the importance of removing stigmas associated with it; some of the warning signs we need to be aware of including other issues in our communities. Eight years ago he founded and remains the director of Makom Meshutaf (Unified Place), which offers non-denominational and non-coercive Jewish educational programming throughout Israel's Pre Military Academies and Kibbutzim and is now under the auspices of the World Mizrachi organization. Rabbi Hammer has authored five books, and is a renowned guest lecturer for communities throughout Israel and the Diaspora including USA, United Kingdom, Australia, South Africa, Canada and Hong Kong.
