Nativity Treasurer's Report - October 2018

Provided below is a brief summary of the October 2018 financial news. We continue to maintain our position of operating better than budget and showing income better than expenses for the year.

- 1. Offerings in October totaled \$38,253 compared to the budget of \$46,268 so we were down \$8,015 for the month. Expenses, however, were \$5,967 better than budget. We did not have a senior pastor in October which accounted for much of the decrease in expenses compared to the budget.
- 2. The Preschool program's income in October was \$34,985 and the expense was \$34,985.
- 3. The Freedom Fund has \$12,473 in the fund this month after completion of the paving job and moving \$15,000 to the Organ Fund in accordance with the Council vote in September.
- 4. Year to date we have added \$15,000 (\$1,500 a month) to our capital improvement fund which now totals \$32,009.
- 5. The total net income (income minus expenses) for the <u>year</u> as of the end of October is +\$46,290 better than budget which is a great way to continue the year.
- 6. In addition, our total net income for the year is +\$27,571.
