General Guidelines

- * Everyone at the meeting has a voice/vote in book selection.
- * Safe Space: Everyone's opinion is important. Anything said in the group, stays in the group.
- * Books may be brought to the meeting to share/loan to others.
- * A list of books with date and synopsis, and any decisions made by the group shall be kept.

Discussion Guidelines

- 1. What is your overall opinion of the book?
- 2. What do you believe is the message the author is trying to convey to the reader? What did you learn from this book? Was it educational in any way?
- 3. Why do you think the author chose the title? Is there a significant meaning behind it?
- 4. Is there a part of the novel you didn't understand? Are you confused by a character's actions or the outcome of the event?
- 5. Do you think the setting, both time and location, played a large roll in this novel? Could it have happened anywhere, at any time? If so, how would the novel have changed?
- 6. How does this book relate to you as a follower of Christ? How does the book touch your life?

If there is time: The circumstance that sets the book in motion is called the inciting moment. What was the inciting moment of this book?

Describe the character development. Who did you identify with? Did your opinions about any of the characters change over the course of the book?
