Applicants should hold a PhD and/or MD degree and have strong laboratory and analytical skills. Experience in molecular biology, immunology, bioinformatics, or cancer genetics would be very helpful.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conducts research focused on immunotherapy and cancer genomics.
- Plans, organizes, performs and monitors daily project protocols.
