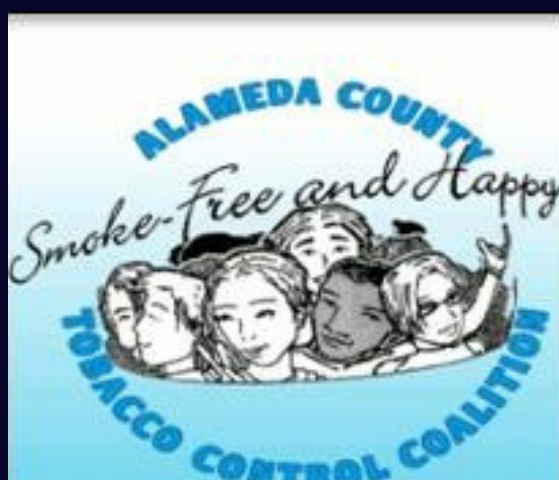

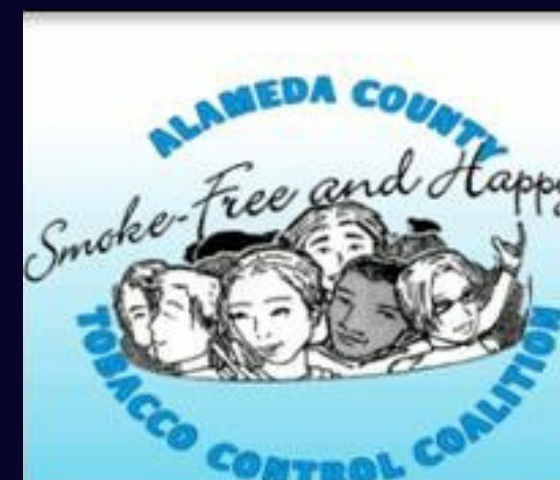

WHY THIS IS IMPORTANT:

- Flavored tobacco products attract youth: 4 of 5 youth smokers started with a flavored product.
- Tobacco companies aim to hook kids early; most smokers start between ages 12-17.
- In a 2018 survey of 48 stores that sell tobacco in Alameda, 100% sold flavored products.
- Almost 1-in-4 AUSD 11th graders reported using e-cigarettes or vape devices.
