Thank you for your support of young people through the Boy Scouts of America. Scouting is undergoing some major program changes. We wanted to make sure you were aware of these changes and had opportunity for input regarding some of these decisions. It is important to remember that human nature is often uncomfortable with change, but we must remember our primary focus to develop our youth remains unwavering.

With that in mind, we will be expanding our Cub Scout membership to serve the whole family including interested young girls starting this fall. This change was driven by our Scouting families asking why our quality program could not be offered to the girls who were often sitting next to the boys at the same meetings and outings.

Each Organization that charters a Cub Scout Pack has a voice in this process. We need to know if you desire to include young girls in your units or wish to remain boys only. Boy Scouting units will need to make the same decision as girls will be able to join in 2019.

I am asking each charter organization or their Scouting leadership to contact us by March 23, 2018 with your Charter Organization's unit Cub Scout decision. If we have not heard from you by August 1st, 2018 we will assume you will enroll girls.
