They will be here all weekend to talk about equine nutrition and feeds they offer. We will recognize our "Lifetime" trail club members and give details on the weekend activities including the filmed trail ride with TV host Tom Seay. Spend time with America's number one Trail Master, Tom Seay, who successfully guided Two cross country horseback trail rides, the 3,300 mile Atlantic to Pacific ride and the 2,500 mile Mexico to Canada ride. Tom has hosted over 1,000 television episodes and was featured in the European Documentary "The American West".

9:30: ARENA - Grand Opening Ceremony - Gather on your horse ready to ride with TV Host Tom Seay.

10:00: Filmed trail ride with TV host Tom Seay & staff on sandy trails through wooded trails covered by pines and live oak trees along the historic tea colored Suwannee River. Walk only ride for any level rider.

Trail ride is approximately 1.5 -2 hrs.

- 1:30:** Guided trail ride with Best of America by Horseback Staff along the historic, tea-colored Suwannee River on sandy trails under pines and live oaks draped in Spanish moss. Approximately 1.5-2 hrs. Walk only ride, suitable for any level rider.
- 3:00:** **Seminole Feed Seminar**- Learn about equine nutrition from this family owned feed company with its headquarters in Ocala, FL (Bring your lawn chair to the Seminole Tent)
- 4:00:** **Seminar on “Bits and Biting” by John Dalziel** - John will talk about the correct fitting of bits, types of bits, how a bit works and how to select a bit for your horse. John’s background includes, training Mounted Police Units around the country, Senior Riding Instructor or Metropolitan Police of London, Training National Guard in Saudia Arabia in use of horses for crown control, trainer for Lake County Sheriff’s Posse in FL, he also teaches dressage, show jumping, cross-country and drill teams among others. (Location - Banquet Hall)
- 6:30:** **BANQUET HALL** - Join us for a banquet dinner hosted by Spirit of the Suwannee Music Park with keynote speaker, Tom Seay.
