Narrated Anas (may Allāh be pleased with him) that:

The Prophet (peace be upon him) said: "A person who wants abundance in his provision, and his age to be lengthened, then he should do favor to his blood relations."

Agreed upon

Lessons to be learned from the hadīth:

- 1. Islām commands that we keep strong family relationships.
- 2. Keeping the ties of the families is one of the means that will increase the provisions of the Muslims.
- Keeping the family ties is one of the things that will bless our lives and our age.
- The great concern of the Prophet (peace be upon him) was to teach his followers the good of this life and the good of the hereafter.
