## **Bone Marrow Transplant Facts:**

- Bone Marrow Transplantation offers the best prospect for cure
- Only 30 percent of patients who need a bone marrow transplant have a matching donor in their families.
- The remaining 70 percent must hope that a compatible stranger can be found using the national registry.
- The number of South Asian donors available in the national registry is very small.
- Registration is online and testing is by a quick swab inside the cheek done at home.
- Donating bone marrow is safe: More than 35,000 people have donated bone marrow to a stranger without a single donor death or disability.
