Lead teacher

Quranic Teachers

- Must also have a qualification in Tajweed.

Assistant Teachers

- High school diploma/GED required, preferably a graduate from the Islamic Weekend School or equivalent school.
- Dedicated, Organized and creative.
- Must be able to assume postures in low levels to allow physical and visual contact with children, see and hear well enough to keep children safe, and engage in physical activity with children
