

Dog Fun Days!



Being a shelter dog is not easy. It's a scary, boring, and often sad life. Here at Ramona Humane Society, we look for ways to make the life of our shelter animals easier by having volunteers sign up to take dogs out of the shelter on special outings. Whether to the beach, a park, a hike, taking dogs away from the shelter gives our volunteers a much more accurate picture of each dog's behaviors and personality. Volunteers take photos of the dogs doing activities that would be impossible at the shelter. These fun days occasionally turn in to sleepovers at the volunteer's home. All these activities enrich the lives of these homeless animals. But more importantly, they help us gather information about the dog--such as how they may behave when not surrounded by shelter stress. Volunteers complete "report cards" (example on next page) when returning the dog to the shelter. The information helps us learn how the dog may behave in a new home. At times, we learn if the dog gets along with other types of pets. Long-term dogs that have participated in the "Furry Friend Fun Day", have been adopted.


