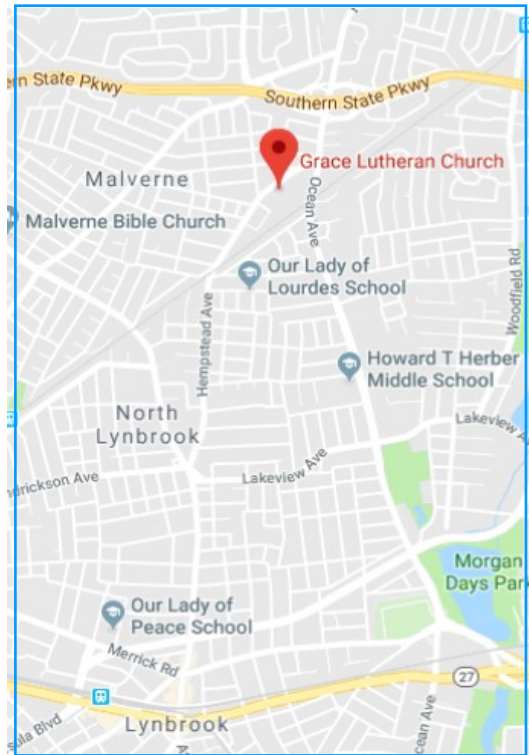
### OUR GOAL:

### Some Excerpts from *The Agile Church*

"Churches today find themselves disoriented, grieving, confused, stuck, amidst the changing cultural realities of the twenty-first century world. The ending hasn't worked out like we expected. We don't know what to do."

"Leadership in the agile church is about fostering the places where people can learn, practice, and play . . . where people can engage in relative safety with the tough questions for which there are no easy answers."

"The work before us is about focusing and re-rooting – discerning what to hold onto and what to let go of as we claim more deeply our identity in the gospel."

"The practice of innovating within established congregations brings with it all sorts of opportunities and challenges. Starting new forms of Christian community can allow for greater freedom for cultural interpretation. What does leadership mean within both of these, and how can church life be restructured and patterned to foster innovation?"

"Innovation involves a shift in imagination that comes through practices and participatory engagement with the biblical narrative; we live our way into new patterns through small experiments rather than dreaming up an aspirational vision far from today's realities."

### OUR WORKSHOP LEADER

Dwight Zscheile joined the Luther Seminary faculty in 2008. He has a B.A. degree with distinction from Stanford University, attended Oxford University, has a Master of Divinity degree from Yale Divinity School, and Doctor of Philosophy degree from Luther Seminary with a focus on congregational mission and leadership in 2008. He is the author of several books and articles on congregational leadership.

He was ordained in The Episcopal Church in 2005 and has served on mission and leadership task forces in the Dioceses of Minnesota and Virginia, and on the Task Force for Reimagining the Episcopal Church.
