# **Satan's three D's**

(doubt + disbelieve = disobey)

## **Genesis chapter 3**

Doubt            vs1...has God indeed said?

Disbelieve    vs4...you will surely not die!

Disobey        vs6...she took it and ate.

# A DEEPER MAGIC



'No, the wisdom we speak of is the mystery of God —his plan that was previously hidden, even though he made it for our ultimate glory before the world began. **But the rulers of this world have not understood it; if they had, they would not have crucified our glorious Lord.** ' 1 Cor 2:7&8

**Jesus predicts it:**

'For when a strong man is fully armed and guards his palace, his possessions are safe— until someone even stronger attacks and overpowers him, strips him of his weapons, and carries off his belongings. **Luke 11:21-22**

**Paul describes it:**

In this way, he disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by his victory over them on the cross.' **Colossians 2:15**

**John recounts it:**

.....for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down. **Revelation 12:10b**

# THE LAMB OF GOD
