What are the *Secondary Specialty Programs* offered in Stafford County Public Schools?

Career & College Pathways Programs encompass specialty-type program opportunities available to high school students in Stafford County Public Schools. The programs vary in nature and scope as they relate to the students' academic and career quests of the student. Each SCPS high school provides unique opportunities for students to select challenging and interesting programs to meet their unique learning needs, styles, and preferences. These programs include the following: Advanced Placement Capstone (AP), Commonwealth Governor's School (CGS), Career & Technical Education (CTE) (application based only), Dual Enrollment (DE), International Baccalaureate®Diploma Programme (IB), Junior Reserve Officer Training Corp (JROTC), and three Stafford Academy for Technology programs (STAT).

What is the *Career & College Pathways Night* at Brooke Point High School?

The event provides parents and students an opportunity to experience an overview of all of the secondary specialty-type programs offered in SCPS (AP, CGS, CTE, DE, IB, JROTC, STAT) in a career and college fair atmosphere.
