- Must meet the income guidelines outlined in brochure.
- Must be willing to partner with Habitat for Humanity.
- Must be unable to afford necessary improvements.
- Must be willing to make loan payments
- Ability to Pay: If approved applicant(s) will assume a 0% interest loan (with conditions) based on the repair cost. Our low income families typically pay a monthly loan payment of between \$25 and \$50.
- Your Residency: All applicant(s) must be United States citizens or legal permanent residents. Applicant(s) must have lived or worked in Colusa, Glenn, Sutter, or Yuba County for at least 1 year and be residing in the home needing repair.
- Your Willingness to Partner: Applicants
 must fully participate in the application
 process, attend any preparation classes,
 work with the sponsoring organization,
 participate in publicity, complete at least
 25 hours of required Sweat Equity and
 exhibit a willingness and ability to partner.
- Credit Check: All family members living in the home 18 years of age and older must agree to a consumer disclosure.
