

Partnership Board of Directors Opening

Dear Community Action Colleagues,

We are reaching out today as we have a vacancy on the Partnership board as a result of a recent resignation.



There is currently an **opening for the position Third Vice-Chair for the term running through August, 2020**. The Partnership's bylaws call for the Partnership board to fill the position for the remainder of the term and as part of this process, the board is seeking nominations from the Network. Please consider nominating someone or consider running yourself. This is a unique opportunity to become part of the Partnership's Board of Directors.

As per the bylaws, the Third Vice-Chair shall perform all duties and functions as from time to time are assigned by the Chair or by the Board of Directors. In the event of the office of Second Vice-Chair becomes permanently vacant for any reason whatsoever, the Third Vice-Chair shall fill the unexpired term of the Second Vice-Chair and shall assume all the duties of such office.

Given this is an officer position, nominees must be a current Executive Director of a local Community Action Agency or State Association who has been a member of the Partnership in good standing for at least one year from the date of the most recent Annual Meeting (8/29/18).

Partnership Board **Regional Representatives** will be collecting names and short bios of interested candidates. **Contact information for regional representatives can be found [here](#)**. All nominations must be submitted by Regional Representatives by January 4, 2019. The ballot with all qualified nominations listed will be provided to the Partnership Board at their January 18th meeting and they will cast votes elect the the new Third Vice Chair.

The new Third Vice-Chair will be invited to attend and be sworn in at the next Partnership board meeting scheduled for Tuesday, March 19 in Washington, DC at the Partnership's offices.

Also, given these recent changes we are pleased to announce that Dalitso Sulamoyo, PhD. has been named First Vice-Chair, and Biz Steinberg has been named the Second Vice-Chair of the Partnership's Board in accordance with the bylaws.
