

WHY PAY FOR SOMETHING THAT'S FREE?

Forsyth Free Tax, a program of Experiment in Self-Reliance (ESR) offers free tax preparation for people who qualify.

Taxes will be prepared at ESR and the Robert Strickland Center at Forsyth Technical Community College (FTCC). Appointments are required for drop-offs. Virtual options may be available. ESR and the Robert Strickland Center at FTCC are the only Forsyth Free Tax sites that will be open this season.

ONE

Call ESR or the FTCC
Robert Strickland Center to
make an appointment to
drop off your tax
information.

TWO

Drop off your tax information at ESR or the FTCC Robert Strickland Center at the specified time. Make an appointment to return.

Photo ID, Social Security Card or individual tax identification number (ITIN for you, spouse and dependents), W-2s, 1099s, other tax documents, ID or SS numbers of childcare providers, last year's tax return, direct deposit information (bank routing and account numbers), and Form 1095-A if healthcare coverage is through the Marketplace, Affordable Care Act (ACA).

THREE

An IRS-certified volunteer will prepare your taxes within 72 hours. Your tax preparer will meet with you at your follow-up appointment before submitting your tax return.
