

## Psalm 68:1-10

**For the director of music. Of David. A psalm. A song.**

- <sup>1</sup> May God arise, may his enemies be scattered;  
may his foes flee before him.
- <sup>2</sup> May you blow them away like smoke—  
as wax melts before the fire,  
may the wicked perish before God.
- <sup>3</sup> But may the righteous be glad  
and rejoice before God;  
may they be happy and joyful.
- <sup>4</sup> Sing to God, sing in praise of his name,  
extol him who rides on the clouds<sup>[b]</sup>;  
rejoice before him—his name is the LORD.
- <sup>5</sup> A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows,  
is God in his holy dwelling.
- <sup>6</sup> God sets the lonely in families,<sup>[c]</sup>  
he leads out the prisoners with singing;  
but the rebellious live in a sun-scorched land.
- <sup>7</sup> When you, God, went out before your people,  
when you marched through the wilderness,<sup>[c]</sup>
- <sup>8</sup> the earth shook, the heavens poured down rain,  
before God, the One of Sinai,  
before God, the God of Israel.
- <sup>9</sup> You gave abundant showers, O God;  
you refreshed your weary inheritance.
- <sup>10</sup> Your people settled in it,  
and from your bounty, God, you provided for the poor.

## Psalm 68:32-35

- <sup>32</sup> Sing to God, you kingdoms of the earth,  
sing praise to the Lord,
- <sup>33</sup> to him who rides across the highest heavens, the ancient heavens,  
who thunders with mighty voice.
- <sup>34</sup> Proclaim the power of God,  
whose majesty is over Israel,

whose power is in the heavens.

<sup>35</sup> You, God, are awesome in your sanctuary;  
the God of Israel gives power and strength to his people.  
Praise be to God!

## **John 17:1-11**

### **Jesus Prays to Be Glorified**

**17** After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed:

“Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you. <sup>2</sup> For you granted him authority over all people that he might give eternal life to all those you have given him. <sup>3</sup> Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent. <sup>4</sup> I have brought you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do. <sup>5</sup> And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began.

### **Jesus Prays for His Disciples**

<sup>6</sup> “I have revealed you<sup>[a]</sup> to those whom you gave me out of the world. They were yours; you gave them to me and they have obeyed your word. <sup>7</sup> Now they know that everything you have given me comes from you. <sup>8</sup> For I gave them the words you gave me and they accepted them. They knew with certainty that I came from you, and they believed that you sent me. <sup>9</sup> I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours. <sup>10</sup> All I have is yours, and all you have is mine. And glory has come to me through them. <sup>11</sup> I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of<sup>[b]</sup> your name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one.
