LOOKING FOR MEANINGFUL WORK?

Reading Futures is changing children's lives across the nation.

In grade 4-12 classrooms across the country, there are students who cannot decode unfamiliar words, cannot read informational text independently, and have spent years believing that reading is something that happens to other people. Some have dyslexia. Some missed foundational instruction. Some are English Learners. What they share: they need high-dosage, highly specialized intervention — and the window to help them is closing.

Most reading programs were designed for young children. The methods are too slow, the texts are too juvenile, and the approach is wrong for adolescents who are acutely aware of their peers. Reading Futures was built specifically for these students.

We hire certified teachers to teach virtual small-group intervention sessions. Teachers receive training on effective, proven intervention programs, are compensated for training and prep time, and join a community of serious educators, researchers, and advocates committed to changing outcomes for historically underserved children.

This role is a flexible part-time W2 position. We welcome military spouse applicants – more than a half of our teachers are military spouses today.
