OUR MISSION AND IMPACT:

At Combined Arms, we believe no veteran should have to navigate civilian life alone or repeat their story to a dozen different agencies just to get help. Our mission is to deliver innovative technology solutions that improve the quality of life for veterans, service members, and military families. In plain terms: we're the connector. Through one coordinated intake, we link the military community to 300+ vetted partner organizations — including trusted employment partners like VetJobs — across all 50 states, so veterans get to the right resource at the right time.

A decade in, the proof is in the numbers. We've connected 100,000+ veterans and family members to life-changing resources since 2015. In 2025 alone, we served 20,765 individuals, made 61,768 resource connections, and delivered \$116.7M in economic impact — a \$1.56 return on every dollar invested. The average wait for help in our network? About 22 hours. Founded and led by veterans, this isn't just our work, it's our calling.
