



Kathleen Guthrie to Spearhead Brain Institute's Educational Initiatives

BOCA RATON, Fla. (Jan. 17, 2018) – The FAU Brain Institute has appointed Kathleen Guthrie, Ph.D., as assistant director for educational programs of the FAU Brain Institute, effective January 2. In her new role, Guthrie will oversee the institute's contribution to neuroscience academic programming with emphasis on the recently inaugurated graduate neuroscience training program and the post-baccalaureate Research Scholars Program.
