International students were encouraged to submit photos highlighting their inspirational international or personal experiences from their home countries. Students will have their photos placed on display in the Green Bay campus commons all week.




Irish Dance with Live Music from Derek Byrne & Paddygrass Presented by Milwaukee Irish Dance Company

Global Spotlight: Life Lessons from the Camino de Santiago

The Camino de Santiago (Way of St. James) is a pilgrimage dating back to the Middle Ages where pilgrims make their way on foot to the burial site of the Apostol St. James at the Santiago de Compostela Cathedral in Spain. Anne Oestreicher, Legal Studies instructor in the College of Business, will discuss lessons learned during her 360-mile, 40-day walk along the most popular Camino route, the Camino Frances.
