## Loan Periods & Item Limits

Patrons in good standing (owing less than \$5) may check out up to the following:

- All Books (excluding New Adult Fiction)
- Audio Books (Limit 3)

### 14-Day Loan Period

- New Adult Fiction
- Magazines
- DVDs (Limit 3)
- CDs (Limit 3)
- Games/Puzzles (Limit 3)

- Hotspots (Limit 1)

## Lost, Stolen, or Missing Items & Cards

Patrons are responsible for all materials checked out on their card including lost and damaged items. Lost cards can be replaced at no cost.

## Renewing Items

Most items automatically renew when due, up to the maximum number of renewals, unless requested by other patrons.

## Access the Library Online

## Fines & Fees

There are no daily incremental fines for most overdue items, excluding Hotspots, Streaming Services, and Launchpads. However, if an account has overdue items, no new items can be checked out until they are returned. Replacement fees will be charged if items are not returned.

## How to Get a Library Card

Adults must provide a photo ID with current address to register. If address is incorrect, a utility bill or rental agreement with correct name and address may be used in its place. Children must have a parent or guardian present with one of the above mentioned items.

## Cards for Children 17 & Under

Parents are responsible for their children's library cards. Only legal guardians/custodians are allowed to access a child's card. Parents may allow permissions for a child to check out movies and/or to use public computers.

## Help Build the Next Chapter of the Francis J. Stallo Memorial Library in Minster

For generations, the Francis J. Stallo Memorial Library has been part of the heart of Minster. From its beginnings in 1963 in the basement of the Minster State Bank, to its home in the historic 1912 Kramer Building since 1976, the library has grown alongside our community. Now, it's time for the next chapter.

For more than 23 years, the library has remained largely unchanged. This renovation will honor the past while creating welcoming, functional spaces for future generations as a beautiful community center.

Planned improvements include: **elevator access** for all, **meeting and study rooms** for learning and connection, a custom **children's discovery area** to inspire learning through play, **enhanced technology** and **updated furnishings**, comfortable community **gathering spaces**, a **coffee bar**, and **quiet areas** for adults.



Garmann Miller has developed the design for the renovation. The overall projected cost of the project is approximately \$1.8 million. A portion of the funds for this project has been set aside for many years from state funds and with help of the Village of Minster. Scope of the entire project is dependent on fundraising. Final cost is yet to be determined. Our goal is to raise the funds through local donations and state grants to help fund this renovation.
