Workshops Offered

Finance in the Local Church, led by Heidi Harding, Associate Director of Financial Services, INUMC

Ensure you are on solid ground with your financial policies. This workshop will provide best practices as well as practical and comprehensive information for today's church, and help you recognize patterns and where weaknesses may occur. Good financial management for treasurers, financial secretaries, and finance chairs.
