History

The Book of Discipline offers the opportunity for each District of the United Methodist Church to establish a *District Missionary Society*. In the Indianapolis Districts, in 1923, a District Missionary Society was formed and given the name of The City Council and Church Extension Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, Indianapolis. The organization was charged with focusing attention, energies and monies on local mission projects. In 1967 the organization's name was changed to The Methodist Board of Missions and Church Extension of Indianapolis.

With merger of Methodist and Evangelical United Brethren churches in 1968 there was the joining of the Indianapolis and Lebanon District Missionary Societies and was renamed The United Methodist Board of Missions of Metropolitan Indianapolis, Inc. (UMBMMI)

In 1997 UMBMMI's name changed to **Metro Ministries, Inc.** and work began with mission and programming in Indianapolis East and West Districts.

The Strategic Agenda Team and the Metro Ministries Board worked in 2010-2011 toward redefining Metro as a ministry within the Indiana Conference with the help of Walker Information with a survey involving clergy and laity giving direction to the Metro Ministries Board.
