In 2016, with a vision of unification in a time that seemed ripe for it, the faith community of Indianapolis came together to build two homes with the Ojo and Anthony Families. In 2017 we are setting out to unite our community alongside two more families and their new community by building two new homes.

We will unite the faith community in Indianapolis to do something that will continue to speak loudly to our neighbors. This September, congregations, mosques, and synagogues will work together again with Greater Indy Habitat for Humanity to serve two families in our community.

Habitat is a partnership founded on common ground—bridging theological differences by putting love into action. Everyone can use the hammer as an instrument to manifest God's love. Habitat's late founder, Millard Fuller, called this concept "the theology of the hammer." "We may disagree on all sorts of other things," said Fuller, "but we can agree on the idea of building homes with God's people in need. Whether you currently partner, have partnered or have never partnered, we invite you to join us as we build two homes north of downtown alongside the Stone and Taylor Families starting in early September. We invite you and your congregation will join us in building this interfaith partnership that builds hope, homes and community.

Building a home is an extravagant action of love and takes a lot of resources and human power to complete. We need to raise the total \$150,000 needed to provide safe, decent and affordable homes for the Stone and Taylor Families. In addition to a financial pledge, we also hope that members of your congregation will assist with the building of the homes.

In 2016, over 50 congregations participated in the Interfaith Builds. In order to build this unique partnership, we invite you to join the work again in 2017. We invite you to prayerfully consider partnership.
