*Lacey Fire responded to 2,300 calls to help fall victims in 2019*

*Mobility, vision and hearing impairments increase risk of fire injury*

*60% of fatal falls occur within the home*

*Those age 65 and older have a 2.5 times greater risk of fatality from a kitchen fire*

*Falls are the leading cause of fatal injury and the most common cause of nonfatal human related hospital admissions for seniors*
