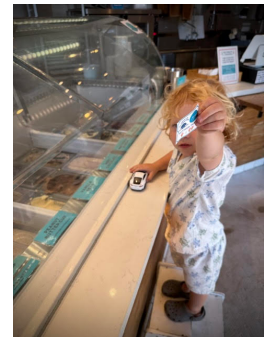

PRESIDENT'S CORNER
