The agency's vision focuses on three critical areas: reduce suicide among men at high risk, strengthen the father-child relationship, and guarantee safety for all those experiencing family violence. The failure to adequately address the health and wellness of

boys and men profoundly affects everyone: all of us have men in our lives who, at one time or another, have been in desperate need of support. The Canadian Centre for Men and Families regularly provides that support to its approximately 600 active clients.

About the Charity



Canadian Centre for Men and Families

Men are socialized to be strong and stoic. As a result, they often avoid seeking the help and support they need. Meanwhile, community services geared to boys, men and fathers are badly underdeveloped.

All of this is happening just as boys and men face a crisis in their health and well-being. Male suicide rates are rising just as their university enrollment numbers are falling. Men are twice as likely to abuse drugs or alcohol, and comprise over 75% of the emergency shelter population. As more couples divorce or separate, more children suffer the serious consequences of father-absence.

But the Canadian Centre for Men and Families presents a game-changing opportunity to reverse these devastating trends. Located throughout Canada, the Centre's are first-of-theirkind hubs for services, research, advocacy, outreach and public education focused on the health and well-being of boys, men, fathers and families. Our vision is to:

- 1. Reduce suicide among men at risk through intervention programs that directly address barriers that men face in getting help;
- 2. Empower fathers undergoing separation or divorce through fathering groups that strengthen the father-child relationship;
- 3. Mentor at-risk boys and young males to foster deeper engagement with family, school and community.

In addition, in early 2021 we opened the first emergency residential facility in Canada for fa-thers and children escaping family violence.

Our men's mental health, father involvement and trauma support programs address a wide variety of complex social problems. Helping boys and men address their problems in positive ways results in healthier families and stronger communities.

Even in the best of times, men often suffer from a lack of strong social networks. During the COVID-19 pandemic, our programs have the added benefit of providing boys and men with social engagement in response to the isolating effect of distancing policy.

The old adage "Take it like a man" must give way to a modern understanding that none of us should have to suffer in silence.
