

## Food and Nutrition Services

**2021-2022**

**The USDA has extended free breakfast and lunch to all APS students for the entire 2021-2022 school year.**



Students will be expected to go through the serving line this year. All meals in elementary schools will be packed to travel. In secondary schools students will have the option of a lunch tray or a bag.

To start the school year, salad bars and self serve fruit and vegetable bars will be closed. There will be no sale of a la carte items in elementary schools. Secondary schools will offer limited a la carte items.

Breakfast is the most important meal of the day! Breakfast will be packed to allow students to eat in the classroom. Breakfast will be served in the cafeteria or at a central entrance location.

Milk will not be available a la carte. Students bringing a lunch from home will be able to select a bag consisting of milk, fruit and a vegetable to complement their meal.
