LATIN AMERICA LEADERS SUMMIT 2026

GUATEMALA

Under the theme “The Year of Acceleration,” FGBMFI leaders from across Latin America gathered in Guatemala City, Guatemala, on May 29–30, 2026, at the Barceló Guatemala City Hotel.

Leaders representing 12 nations came together for two significant days of instruction, teaching, fellowship, and renewed direction. Latin America united around a common purpose: to receive fresh guidance for the new season of the

Fellowship and prepare its leadership for greater impact throughout the region.

International President Francis Owusu was present and delivered a powerful message to the regional leadership, encouraging the nations to move deeper in the Spirit and respond to the direction God is giving FGBMFI in this season.

The Summit was led by Regional Vice President Manuel Peña of Nicaragua, together with the Regional Vice Presidents

at Large serving Latin America. This regional leadership team, appointed by the International President, continues to work closely with the nations of Latin America, providing support, coordination, and direction to a region that remains in constant movement and continues to experience significant growth and expansion.

Jennifer Owusu, International Ladies Coordinator, also participated in the Summit and held special meetings with ladies’ leaders from across Latin America, strengthening relationships and encouraging greater unity among the women of the Fellowship throughout the region.

Members of the International Board, Rafael Cuestas International Vice President and Douglas Woolley International Secretary, were also present, joining national and regional leaders during this important gathering.

The Guatemala Summit was more than a regional meeting. It became a moment of alignment for Latin America—a region united, receiving new instruction and preparing to move together in The Year of Acceleration.





INTERNATIONAL REVIVAL AND FIRE TEAMS 2026

NICARAGUA, GET READY

From May 2 to 10, 2026, Nicaragua experienced another powerful season of outreach through the International Revival and Fire Teams under the declaration:

Nicaragua, get ready.

More than 3,000 national participants, together with over 230 international members and leaders representing nine nations, gathered throughout the central and southern regions of

Nicaragua with one purpose: to reach people in need through the power of personal testimony.

The Vision continues to move beyond the four walls.

As former International President Richard Shakarian envisioned, FGBMFI men and women would not simply wait for people to come to them. They would leave the four walls and go into the marketplace—to the places where



people live, work, struggle, and search for hope. That Vision continues to be fulfilled in Nicaragua.

From cities to distant villages and rural communities, members of the Fellowship went out to meet people personally, sharing what God had done in their own lives and praying for those in need.

The strategy was simple but powerful: reach one person in every family. Pray



for that person. Share the testimony of Jesus with that person. Let that life become a seed to reach the family—and through families, reach the nation.

Once again, Nicaragua demonstrated the living power of the Fire Teams Vision: ordinary men and women, filled with the Holy Spirit, going where the people are and carrying a testimony of what they have actually experienced of God.

GLOBAL PRAYER DAY

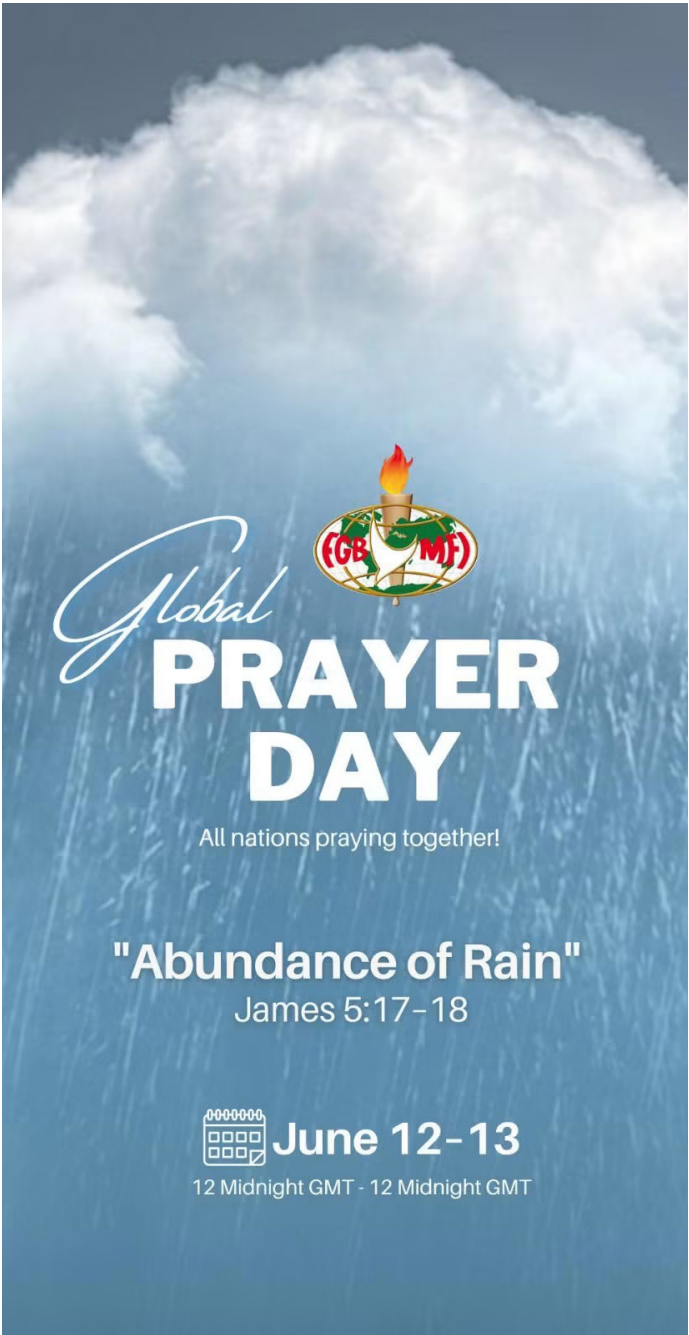
