

Face Mask Covering Guidelines

- Medical Mask (Blue or Green)
- Collegiate cloth mask – representation of any College/University cloth mask will be acceptable
- Face shields – Face shields must reach down to the chest. (Additional cloth covering may be necessary to reach the acceptable coverage.)
- Masks or Gaiters of any color or multi-colored without inappropriate symbols, quotes, or insinuations may be worn.
 - no political symbols or words on mask
 - no inappropriate language on mask
 - no sexual or alcohol referenced symbols or words on mask
 - no gang language, symbols or drug paraphernalia on mask
- N95 Mask
- San Joaquin Memorial cloth mask

Unacceptable Face Mask Coverings

- Bandanas
- Full ski mask

The San Joaquin Memorial Mask Policy states specifically what students may wear on campus, if it is not expressly stated that it can be worn, then it CANNOT be worn

Wear your Face Covering Correctly

- Your face covering must be worn properly at all times
- Wash your hands before putting on your face covering
- Put it over your nose and mouth and secure it under your chin
- Try to fit it snugly against the sides of your face
- Make sure you can breathe easily

The Administration reserves the right to change or interpret which masks or acceptable on campus or at San Joaquin Memorial events.

Carefully, untie the strings behind your head or stretch the ear loops



2
Handle only by the ear loops or ties



3
Fold outside corners together

Be careful not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth when removing and wash hands immediately after removing
